1 Do you know that you have a very powerful muscle in your body? It's so powerful that it could lift a car! Can you guess which one it is? It's your heart, of course. It's not very big, it's about the size of your fist and you can find it in the centre of your chest.

2 Your heart's job is to push blood around your body. It's like a pump – it fills with blood and then squeezes it out – this is your heartbeat. Your heart beats over 100,000 times a day or over two billion times in your life. Your heartbeat keeps you alive. Your heart beats faster when you move because your body needs more oxygen.

3 Your heart brings oxygen to your cells. You have about 4 litres of blood in your body. Your blood makes more than 1000 round-trips through your body every day and your heart pumps more than 7,500 litres of blood – this is more than 95,000 km every day – more than two trips around the world!

4 If you want to make your heart stronger, you have to use it as much as possible. You can run, cycle, swim, jump or do any other exercise, where your heart beats faster than normal. Your heart also grows when you exercise, so it is even more powerful.
